Context

We have provided all data for the last 5 years for comparison.

Outcomes

Today we are celebrating the improvements that we have made. We have improved in all areas but we are a long way from where we need to be. English has managed to hold its own as have Maths which is positive given staffing challenges but we need to strive to get back to being in line or above with National Averages. There is work to be done on English and Maths Match up. French has improved but is still a very weak subject. History has improved but is still not in line with National Average. Science has followed an 8 year upward trajectory and has continued to improve this year but again needs to work to being in line or above National Averages. Subjects that have made significant improvement or have performed particularly well and should be commended are Art, Photography, Dance, Sport, Food, Design and Technology and ICT.

Staff were pretty accurate in PPE's with marks and the results have followed suit.

Saturday School students have performed well in English and Maths from PPE's to actual results.
