#### ICT Acceptable Use Agreement

We expect all ICT users to take responsibility in the following ways:

#### Not to access (or even try to access) any material which is:

- · Violent or which glorifies violence
- Criminal or glorified criminal activity (including drug abuse)
- · Racist or designed to incite racial hatred
- · Pornographic or with otherwise unsuitable sexual content
- Crude, profane or with otherwise unsuitable language
- Blasphemous or mocking of religious and moral beliefs and values of others
- Offensive
- · In breach of the law, including:
  - o Copyright Law
  - o Data Protection Act
  - Computer Misuse Act

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Not to access (or even try to access) any material which belongs to other users of the ICT systems and which you do not have explicit permission to use.

# Not to search for or use websites that by-pass the School's internet filtering and:

- Students are not to access or try to access social networking sites
- Students are not to access or try to access games sites (unless approved by either the Head of Department for ICT or the IT manager)
- Students are not to access or try to access streaming content (such as iPlayer, Grooveshark, youtube, etc.)
- Not to download or try to download any software without the explicit permission of a member of the ICT support staff

# What to do if a child is having an asthma attack

- Help them sit up straight and keep calm.
- 2 Help them take one puff of their reliever inhaler (usually blue) every 30-60 seconds, up to a maximum of 10 puffs.
- 3 Call 999 for an ambulance if:
  - their symptoms get worse while they're using their inhaler this could be a cough, breathlessness, wheeze, tight chest or sometimes a child will say they have a 'tummy ache'
  - they don't feel better after 10 puffs
  - · you're worried at any time.
- You can repeat step 2 if the ambulance is taking longer than 15 minutes.
