KS3

New projects are underway for KS3 students. Year 7 are embarking on a learning journey to discover more about Art from different parts of the world, including Aboriginal Art from the indigenous people of Australia. This term students will learn about the stories and symbols used in the art work as well as the dotting technique used to create so many of the unique aboriginal pieces we see in places like the British Museum. Year 8 continue their learning journey to discover more about 20th Century Art movements with their focus being Surrealism. Students will learn about the juxtaposition of uncommon objects and create their own surrealist pieces looking at how everyday objects can be transformed.

Our focus this term is to refine our observational studies and start planning for some exciting final pieces which we will produce when back in the classroom.
