

Summer reading at Aylesford

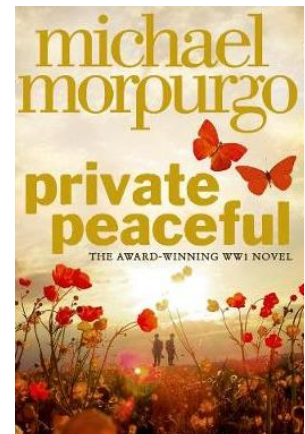
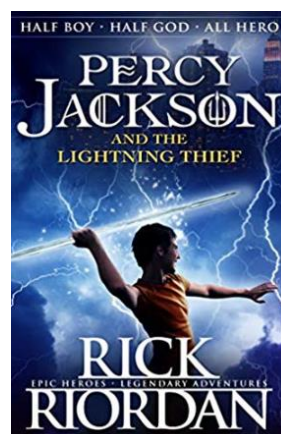
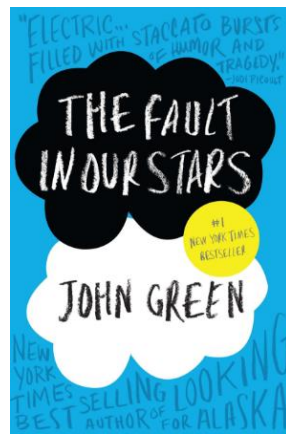
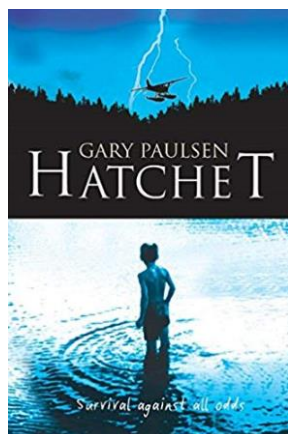

Students who read for pleasure are more likely to succeed in school and the studies show that that reading for pleasure enhances empathy, understanding of the self, and the ability to understand one's own and others' identities.
