UNIT 1

Psychological Approaches and Applications

UNIT 3

Health Psychology

Health psychology explores how psychological and physiological factors affect health and ill health. This unit includes approaches, theories and studies that investigate reasons for behaviour, such as addiction and stress. This unit also explores the effectiveness of different treatments in psychology

UNIT 2

COURSEWORK



Unit 2 ends with students planning, preparing and completing their own pilot study. Internal assessment of three written reports submitted by students on the Unit 2 content.
