



## Sanctions and Consequences

A summary for students and parents.

### Behaviour for Learning

Behaviour for learning refers to student conduct inside the classroom. Where behaviour expectations of a student falls below the high expectations of the school a teacher will issue a 30 minute afterschool detention.

This student will be informed and the **parent/carer will be informed via classcharts** of the time and date of the detention. This will normally be the following day. Students will need to attend the detention in the school hall. Failure to attend will mean that the detention is escalated to a 60 minute detention. Failure to attend a 60 minute detention will result in the student being placed into the schools isolation room. At each of these stages the parent/carer will receive communication via class charts and an email notification.

### Student Conduct – Minor

#### **3 Conduct Logs = 30-minute afterschool detention**

There will be a '3 strike' approach attached to the following behaviours, giving students time and chances to ensure that the 'basic student conduct' is being adhered to on a daily basis.

On the 3<sup>rd</sup> incident, these 'Minor' behaviour this will automatically issue a 30 minute afterschool detention. **Parents will be informed of this via classcharts.** Failure to attend will mean that the detention is escalated to a 60 minute detention. Failure to attend a 60 minute detention will result in the student being placed into the schools isolation room. At each of these stages the parent/carer will receive communication via class charts and an email notification

## Student Conduct – Serious

The following behaviours are considered more serious by the school. These types of behaviours are deliberate, and the school takes these extremely seriously. These type of behaviours can have a negative impact on student and staff safety and also the wellbeing of all members of the school community.

Any behaviour resulting in a 30 minute detention will **be communicated via classcharts for parents**. Failure to attend will mean that the detention is escalated to a 60 minute detention. Failure to attend a 60 minute detention will result in the student being placed into the schools isolation room. At each of these stages the parent/carer will receive communication via class charts and email notification

For **more serious incidents resulting** in isolation or more serious parents will be notified by a phone call

Misuse of school toilets	
Not following the hands-off policy	
Refusing to follow staff instructions/Rudeness to staff	
Refusal to hand over a mobile phone, headphones or other item	
Non-attendance to a 60 minute detention	Isolation
Possession of or use of Illicit substances, including vapes, cigarettes or drugs	<p>Isolation, Suspension or Permanent Exclusion may be considered for these types of serious behaviours depending on the severity of the incident.</p> <p>As well as this being logged and recorded on class charts you will <b>receive a phone call if your child is in isolation or being suspended</b></p> <p>Further information regarding these types of serious incidents can be found in the schools behaviour policy</p>

- If a 30-minute afterschool detention is missed/failed, this will be escalated to a 60-minute afterschool detention.
- If a 60 minute afterschool detention is missed/failed this will be escalated to a day in isolation.
- If isolation is refused or failed then students will be suspended.

**Where behaviours of a certain type are repeated students and parents should expect escalating consequences.**
