In January 2021 Aylesford School aims to begin rapid testing of asymptomatic staff and students.

We aim to establish a small testing facility to enable staff and students to have regular, rapid tests. We will be using the Lateral Flow Tests which will be supplied to us by the government.

We are seeking temporary volunteers from January who can help us between 9am and 1pm Monday to Friday. You may be a parent, a retired teacher or a retired NHS worker. Full training and PPE will be provided.

Without volunteers we will not be able to offer this valuable service.
