**RE: Year 11 Prom**

As a reward for the hard work shown across the last two years of GCSE study we are delighted to be organizing the year 11 prom as a final send off for our year 11 cohort.

The year 11 prom will be held at the **Village Hotel** in Maidstone and the details for the evening are set out below. The evening will include a DJ, Dancefloor, food, refreshments and some other surprises for the year group. We hope that students will be able to attend and celebrate their school journey and the successes they have had over their time at Aylesford School.

**Venue:** Village Hotel Maidstone, Forstal Road, ME14 3AQ

**Date:** Thursday 27<sup>th</sup> June

**Arrival Time:** 7pm

**Prom Finish and Pick up:** 11pm

**Dress Code:** Formal evening wear

The cost of the evening will be **£40** a ticket and the deadline for payment for the event will be **1<sup>st</sup> May**. A non refundable deposit of £15 must be paid by **28<sup>th</sup> March** in order to secure a space to attend the event. All information will be added to parent pay.

The 'ticket to the prom' will be introduced to year 11 in term 5 as a way to support with uniform, expectations and behavior. Students are expected to get this signed by their core and option subject teachers at the end of the week and this will be signed if staff feel that students have upheld the above. This is evidence to support students expectations.

If students fall below the expected expectations set out (listed below) then their place at the prom may be taken away as a result of not meeting the schools expectations. This is of course something we would not wish to do and hope that all of year 11 are able to celebrate together.

- Failure to complete 'Ticket to prom' card from all teachers at the end of each week
- Attendance above 96% - Between term 4 – end of exam period
- Attendance to all exams
- On time for all exams
- Attendance to revision and study sessions prior to exams
- Behaviour follows school expectations and follows school policy
