Dear Parent/Carer and Student,

I am writing to current year 5 students to invite students and their families to attend our Year 6 transition events that commence in the first week of the next academic year. We appreciate that the transition from Primary School to Secondary School can be daunting experience for both students and their parents/carers. 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Year 6 Character Development

At Aylesford we aim to develop students academically but we also strive to make students well rounded individuals. We do this by encouraging the progression of their character. This is done by recognising and rewarding our ten character strengths that were chosen by students, parents/carers and our school governors: respect, self-discipline, courage, open-mindedness, motivation, resilience, confidence, integrity, compassion and curiosity. At Aylesford, we use the development of those character strengths to shape our reward system. Therefore, all students are issued with a character card by their mentor and when character strengths have been demonstrated this is recorded. Students are then invited to enjoy reward events such as graduation ceremonies, pizza and film afternoons and reward trips. We would like to support year 6 students in becoming well rounded individuals and so each student who attends our after school transition sessions that run on Mondays will be issued with a character card and can collect character points each week. There will be rewards for the students to enjoy who have demonstrated various character strengths at the end of the transition sessions.

The vision for Aylesford School

The vision for Aylesford School is to provide 'an education that builds character' - high quality Academic and Character Education which develops confident young people who are successful learners and contribute positively to society. This is underpinned by our strap line 'Courage, Confidence, Character'. Since my appointment in the school, Ofsted have said the following:

In 2017 students in year 11 at Wrotham School achieved more grade 4s and 5s in English and Mathematics than any other non-selective school, along with a positive Progress 8 score. We know that what we are doing at Aylesford will work.

I firmly believe that every student regardless of background or ability can achieve whatever they want with hard work and determination. I am passionate about ensuring that you reach your potential at Aylesford School and believe that if you develop good character strengths you will be successful at whatever you try. At Aylesford School my staff and I have developed a 'Can Do' attitude and are prepared to do whatever it takes to maintain high standards and continually improve progress and attainment.

Our behaviour policy centres on developing and praising character strengths demonstrated by students both in lessons and around the school. We recognise that strong positive relationships are key, as is celebration of success.

'Good' and 'Outstanding' Teaching and Learning are at the forefront of everything that we do and we are fortunate to have a high calibre of teachers working at Aylesford School with Nationally recognised Specialist Leaders in Education in English and Maths and an award winning PE teacher.

Our teachers will stretch and challenge you, provide support when needed and be a source of inspiration.

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It is also really important to us that you enjoy school and we are always looking for opportunities to promote this. You will have opportunities to participate in sports activities, performing arts, charity events, cultural visits which will help to nurture your talents and hopefully provide a love of school – we want you to be happy.
